4.	Text is written in the given template with general text font in ' <i>Book Antiqua</i> ' with 10-point size. Major heading are with the same font of 14-point size, bolded, while minor sub headings are 12-point size, bolded.	
5.	Margins are kept at 20 mm all around, together with an additional binding gutter of 10 mm on the appropriate edge	
6.	The subheadings include (but need not necessarily limited to) the following, and are in the given order: Introduction, Literature Review, Methodology, Results and Discussion, Conclusions, References.	
7.	Tables, figures, and equations are sequentially numbered. Captions are placed with the corresponding figures and tables.	
8.	References are complete, and follow the Harvard referencing format.	
9.	The overall length of the abstract is limited to 3-4 pages.	
10.	The entire abstract is closely reviewed and free of grammatical, spelling and other common language errors
